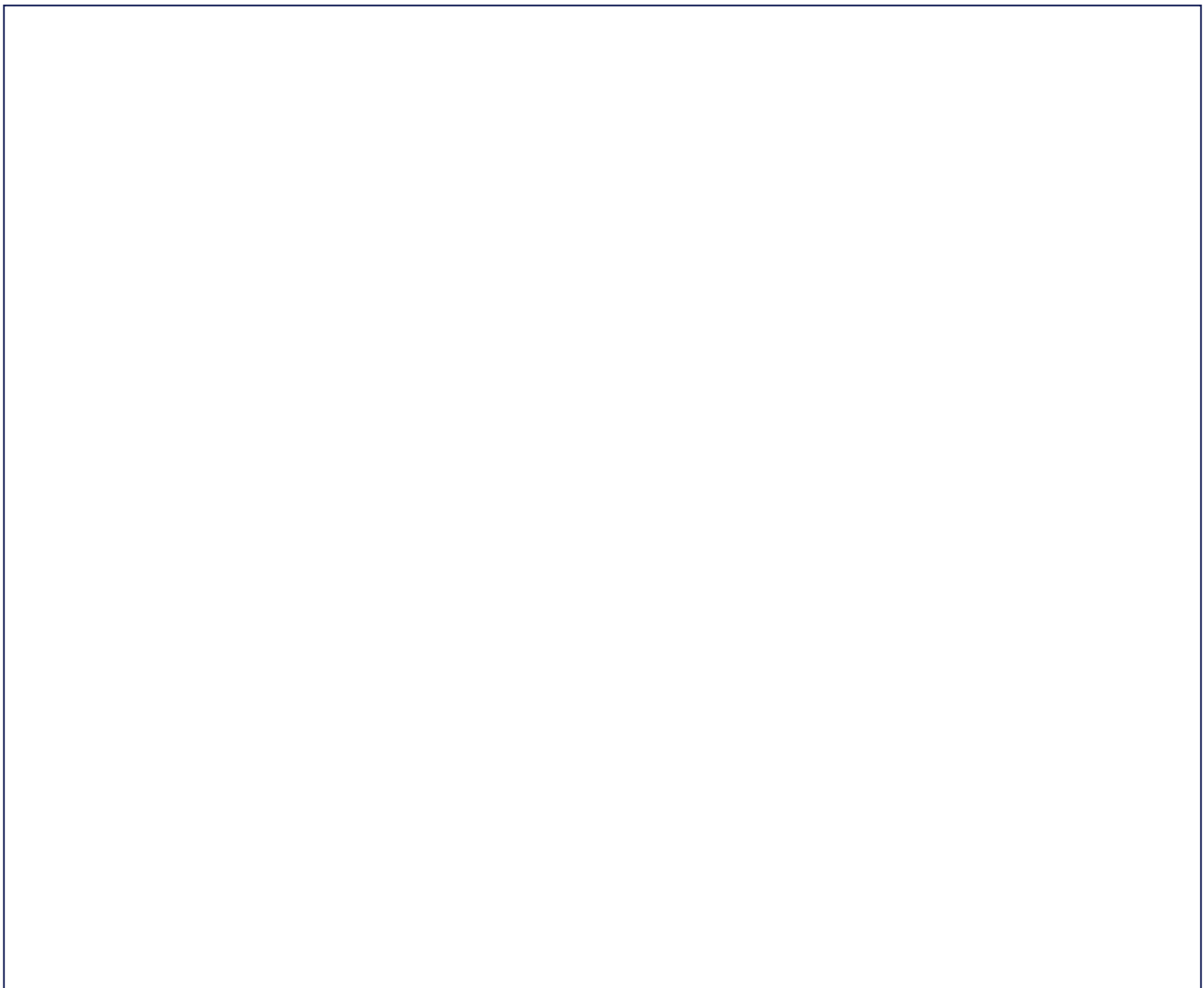


Zara's Christmas Art Workshop

Learning objective: To create a festive Christmas scene using patterns and observational drawing techniques.

Follow the steps below to create your Christmas scene. Zara the Zebra loves using patterns! Try to include different lines and shapes in your drawing.

Draw: Draw a festive Christmas tree in the centre of the page. Use a pencil to sketch the outline first. Add a star at the top. Decorate your tree with three round baubles and a long, curvy piece of tinsel. Draw a square present sitting on the floor under the tree. Use your best colouring pencils to make the patterns bright and festive.



Label words: bauble · tinsel · star · pattern · festive · bright

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large Christmas tree in the middle of your page. Add a big star at the very top. What shape is your star?
2. Step 2: Draw three round baubles on your tree. Add a different pattern to each bauble, like stripes or dots.
3. Step 3: Draw a curvy line of tinsel going around your tree. How many loops does your tinsel have?
4. Step 4: Draw one present under the tree. Use a square shape. Label the present using a word from the word bank.
