6. 6. What is it called when you stick different bits of paper and fabric onto a page to make a picture? (1 mark)

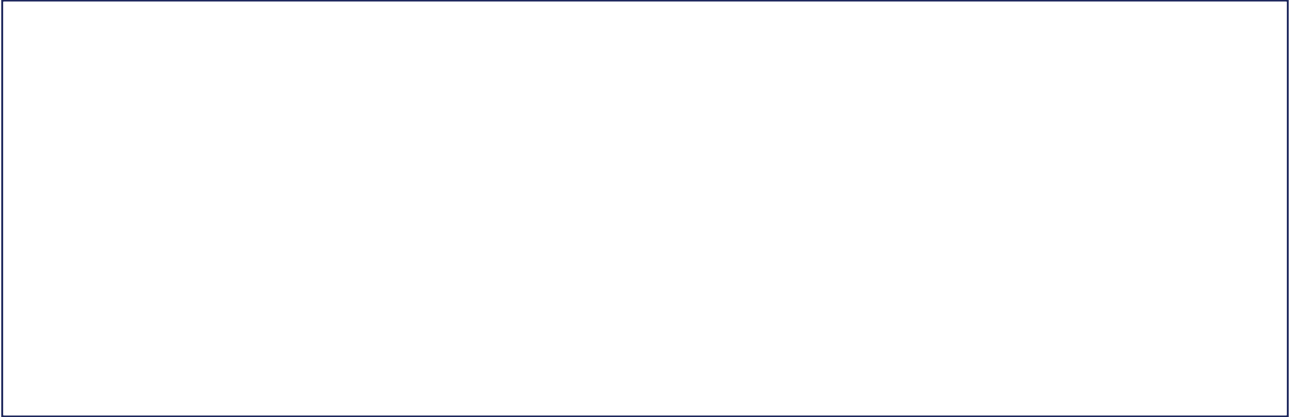
7. 7. Which tool do you use to apply paint to a canvas? A) Scissors B) Glue C) Paintbrush\* D) Ruler (1 mark)
