Learning objective: To use patterns and symmetry to create Christmas-themed artwork.

Zara the Zebra loves patterns! Read each question carefully. Use the word bank if you need help. Write your answers in the boxes provided.

Word bank: Symmetry · Pattern · Texture · Repeat · Contrast

1. Zara wants to paint a snowflake. A snowflake is the same on both sides. What is the name for this design? (2 marks)

2. Look at a Christmas bauble. Name one shape or line you could use to make a pattern on it. (2 marks)

3. If you use red and green together, they look very bright. This is called colour _____. (2 marks)

4. To make a wrapping paper design, you must _____ the same shape many times across the page. (2 marks)

Draw: Zara needs your help! In the space below, draw a Christmas tree. Use a repeating pattern of shapes (like stars, circles, or triangles) to decorate it.



Extension challenge: Can you add a 'texture' to your tree? Try drawing small lines to make it look like prickly pine needles instead of smooth branches.
