6. 6. True or False: You can overlap pieces of paper to create a collage. (1 mark)

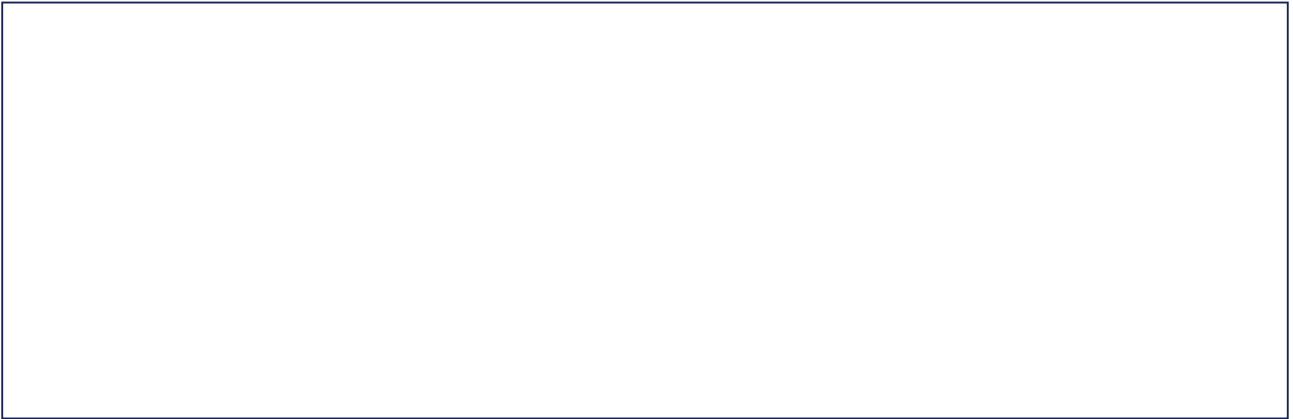
7. 7. Besides paper, what soft material can you stick on your art? (Starts with f...) (1 mark)
