

Zara's Radiant Rangoli Patterns

Learning objective: To understand and create symmetrical patterns inspired by traditional Rangoli designs.

Zara the zebra loves bright colours and patterns! Follow the steps below to design your own Rangoli pattern. Use a pencil to sketch first, then colour it in.

Draw: Draw a Rangoli pattern. Start with a shape in the centre. Add repeating shapes around it to show symmetry. Use bright colours like red, yellow, and orange. Make sure the left side of your drawing matches the right side.



Label words: Symmetry · Pattern · Circle · Diamond · Petal · Border

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large circle in the middle of your page. This is the centre of your design.
2. Step 2: Add four petals around your centre circle. Make sure they are the same size.
3. Step 3: Draw a border around the edge of your paper using a repeating pattern of triangles.
4. Step 4: Label your design using two words from the word bank.
