

Zara's Springtime Easter Garden

Learning objective: To use pattern, colour, and texture to create an Easter-themed illustration.

Follow the steps below to draw your own Easter garden. Use your pencils to add detail and patterns.

Draw: Draw a large, decorated Easter egg sitting in a grassy garden. The egg should be the main focus of the page. Use geometric patterns like zigzags, wavy lines, and dots to decorate the egg. Fill the background with simple spring flowers and a warm sun in the corner.



Label words: pattern · texture · spring · decoration · zigzag · wavy · spotted

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large oval shape in the middle of your page to be the main Easter egg. Add a zigzag pattern across the middle.
2. Step 2: Draw two wavy lines coming out from the bottom of the egg to make the grass. Add three small circles in the grass to be flowers.
3. Step 3: Draw a spotted pattern on the top half of your egg. Use your favourite bright colours.
4. Step 4: Label your drawing using at least two words from the word bank.
