

Zara's Easter Art Studio

Learning objective: To explore patterns and colours to create an Easter-themed design.

Look at the patterns below. Use your pencils or felt-tips to finish the designs. Follow the steps carefully to help Zara the Zebra make her art.

Word bank: pattern · colour · symmetrical · bright · Easter · design · repeat

1. Zara wants to use bright colours for her egg design. List three colours you think are bright and happy for spring. (2 marks)

2. A pattern is something that happens again and again. Draw a simple pattern using a circle and a triangle. (2 marks)

3. Symmetrical means both sides are the same. If you draw a line down the middle of an egg, what would you put on both sides to make it look the same? (2 marks)

4. Zara is selling her art cards for £2 each. If she sells 3 cards, how much money does she make in total? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a large egg shape in the box below. Decorate it with a repeating pattern of stripes and spots. Make sure the colours are very bright!



Extension challenge: Can you design a second egg that is the opposite of your first one? If your first egg had stripes, make this one have zig-zags!
