Word bank: contrast · pattern · texture · bright · spooky · geometric · symmetry

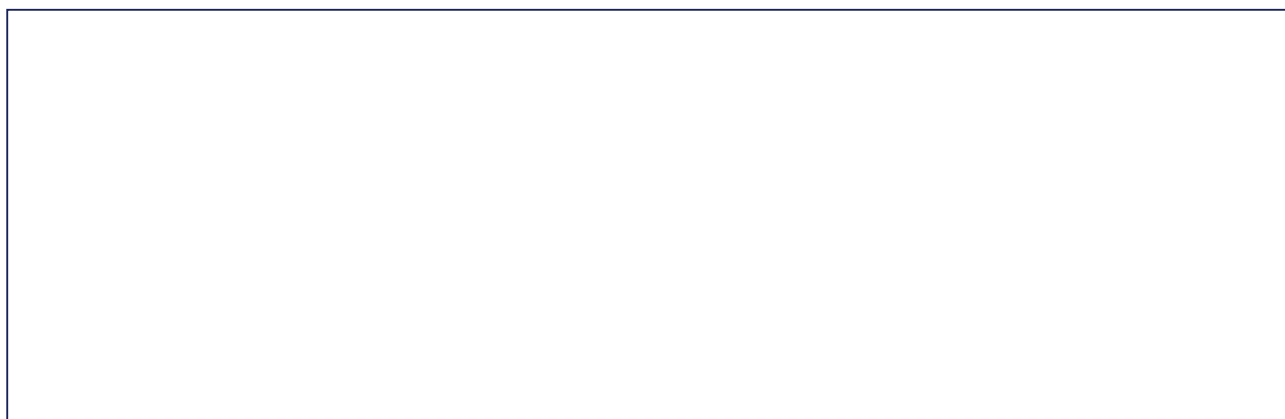
1. Zara the Zebra loves patterns. Look at a pumpkin. What two shapes can you see on a pumpkin's face? (2 marks)

2. Choose two colours that look good together for Halloween. Why do these colours make a good contrast? (2 marks)

3. Zara likes to use repeating lines. Draw a small example of a zig-zag line and a wavy line below. (2 marks)

4. Complete this sentence: To make my art look spooky, I will use _____ lines and _____ colours. (2 marks)

Draw: In the box below, draw a spooky Halloween scene. Use a pattern for the background. You could draw a pumpkin, a bat, or a star-filled sky. Try to use at least three different types of lines.
