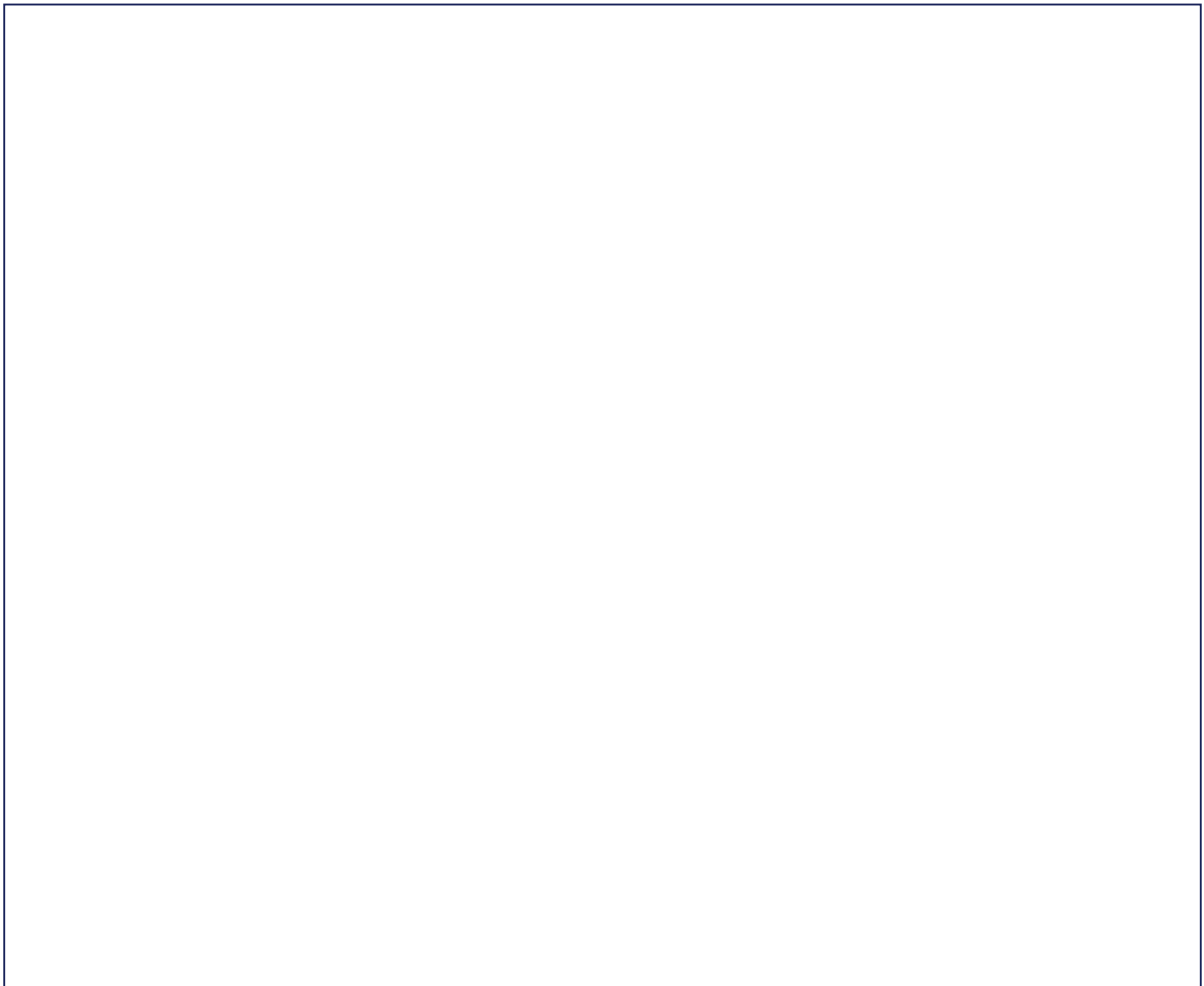


## Zara's Abstract Art Adventure

*Learning objective: To explore the style of Wassily Kandinsky by using geometric shapes and colours to express feelings.*

Follow the steps below to create your own piece of abstract art inspired by Wassily Kandinsky. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing.

**Draw: Create an abstract artwork in the style of Wassily Kandinsky. The scene should not look like real life. Fill the space with overlapping colourful circles, sharp geometric triangles, and balanced squares. Use dark lines to create contrast against bright colours. Zara the zebra says: 'Don't worry about making it look perfect; art is about how the colours make you feel!'**



*Label words: Circle · Square · Triangle · Line · Pattern · Bright · Contrast*

### Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw three large circles in the centre of your page. Use a different colour for each one.
2. Step 2: Draw a straight line and a wavy line that go behind your circles.
3. Step 3: Fill the corners of your page with small squares and triangles to create a pattern.
4. Step 4: Label your drawing using three words from the word bank to show the shapes you used.
