What are the people in Lowry's paintings often called?	What kind of buildings did Lowry often paint in his scenes?
Matchstick men	Factories
What type of paint did Lowry usually use?	How would you describe the colours Lowry used?
Oil paint	A limited colour palette (often using white, black, red, and yellow)
What is the word for a painting of the outdoors or countryside/cityscape?	Where did Lowry live and paint most of his work?
Landscape	Industrial Northern England
What do we call the area at the front of a painting?	What do we call the area at the back of a painting?
Foreground	Background
Did Lowry paint people with lots of detail or simple shapes?	What is the main mood of a Lowry painting?
Simple shapes	Busy and industrial
What is a 'palette'?	True or False: Lowry often painted busy street scenes.
The range of colours an artist uses	True
