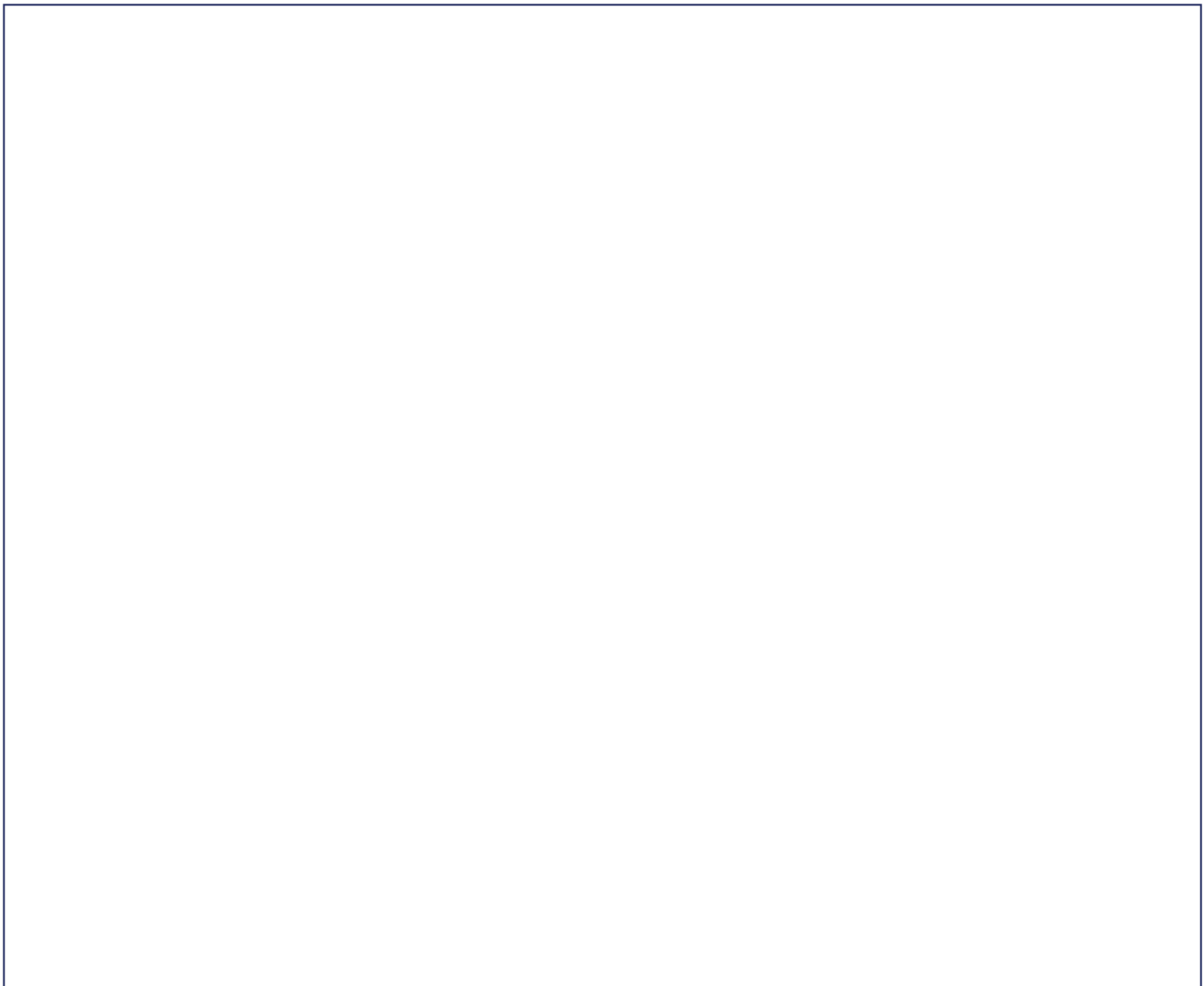


Zara's Perspective Art Challenge

Learning objective: To understand how to show perspective by drawing objects getting smaller as they get further away.

Follow the steps below to draw a path that looks like it goes into the distance. Use your pencil to draw light lines first. Zara the Zebra is here to help you spot patterns!

Draw: Draw a straight path that starts wide at the bottom of the page and gets narrower as it reaches the vanishing point in the centre. Fill the foreground with large flowers and the background with tiny clouds. Use your ruler to keep the path edges straight.



Label words: Horizon line · Vanishing point · Foreground · Background · Perspective

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a straight line across the middle of your page. This is your horizon line. Label it.
2. Step 2: Draw a small dot in the centre of your line. This is the vanishing point. Draw two lines starting from the bottom corners of your page that meet at this dot.
3. Step 3: Draw a tree near the bottom of your page. Make it big. Draw another tree near the vanishing point. Make it very small.
4. Step 4: Label the part of the drawing closest to you as the 'Foreground' and the part near the horizon as the 'Background'.
