Learning objective: To understand the key concepts of Pablo Picasso's style and his contribution to modern art.

Read each card. Zara the zebra loves to look at shapes and colours! Use these cards to learn about a famous artist. You can play a memory game with a partner.

Who was Pablo Picasso?

A famous artist who changed how we look at the world.

What is Cubism?

A style where objects are broken into shapes and put back together.

Does Picasso's art look like a photograph?

No, his art is abstract and uses different shapes.

What shapes did Picasso often use?

He used squares, triangles, and circles.

What is a portrait?

A picture of a person's face.

Did Picasso use bright or dull colours?

He used many different bright colours to show feelings.

Can a face have two eyes on the same side?

Yes, in Picasso's art, he painted faces from many angles at once.

What materials did he use?

He used paint, clay, and sometimes bits of paper.

Is abstract art always realistic?

No, it focuses on shapes and colours instead of real-life detail.

How did Picasso feel about art?

He thought art should be fun and creative.
