- Pablo Picasso was a famous artist who helped invent a style called Cubism. This style uses simple shapes like squares, triangles, and circles to build a picture.
- In Cubist art, artists break objects apart and put them back together in a new way. This makes the art look abstract rather than real.
- Picasso often used bright colours to show different emotions in his paintings.
- He wanted to show many different viewpoints of one object on a flat piece of paper.
- Zara the zebra thinks Picasso's work is like a giant puzzle. You have to look closely to find all the hidden parts of the face!

Did you know? Did you know? Pablo Picasso loved to try new things! He did not just paint what he saw. He painted what he felt and thought about the objects, often showing the front and the side of a person's face at the very same time.
