

Exploring Art with Zara the Zebra

Learning objective: To learn about the artist Pablo Picasso and how he used different perspectives to create portraits.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you write your answers. Think about the shapes and colours Zara the Zebra might use!

Word bank: Picasso · Portrait · Cubism · Shapes · Perspective

1. Who is the famous artist we are learning about today? (1 mark)

2. Picasso painted people in a special style where he showed the front and the side of a face at the same time. What is this style called? (1 mark)

3. Look at the word 'Portrait'. What does this word mean in art? (2 marks)

4. If you were painting a face like Picasso, name two shapes you could use for the eyes or nose. (2 marks)

Draw: Zara the Zebra wants you to draw a self-portrait in the style of Picasso. Draw a face using different geometric shapes like triangles and circles. Make the eyes look in different directions!



Extension challenge: If you were selling your Picasso-style painting in an art shop, how much would it cost? Write a price tag for your artwork using pounds and pence, for example: £5.50.
