Word bank: colourful · pattern · brave · kind · funny · adventure · character · story · bright · imagination

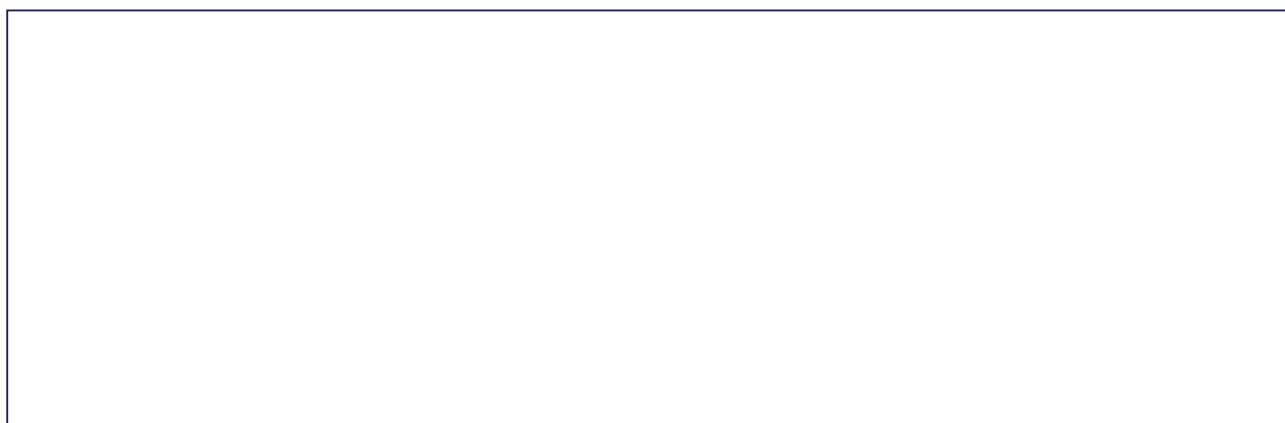
1. Who is your favourite book character? Write their name here. (1 mark)
