

Kit the Fox's Data Sorting Challenge

Learning objective: To sort data into categories and present it in a simple table.

Kit the Fox has been helping the animals at the forest shop. He has a list of items sold today. Help Kit sort these items into a table. Write the name of the item in the correct column: Fruit, Stationery, or Treats.

Word bank: Apple · Banana · Pencil · Rubber · Honey cake · Biscuit · Data · Sort · Table

1. Kit sold: 2 Apples, 1 Pencil, 1 Biscuit, 1 Banana, 1 Rubber, 1 Honey cake. Draw a table with three columns (Fruit, Stationery, Treats) and list the items under the right heading. (3 marks)

2. How many items are in the 'Fruit' column? (1 mark)

3. Which category has the most items? (1 mark)

4. Why is it helpful to put information into a table? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Kit the Fox holding a clipboard with a table on it.

Extension challenge: If an Apple costs £1 and a Biscuit costs £2, what is the total cost of one Apple and one Biscuit? Write your answer as: £...
