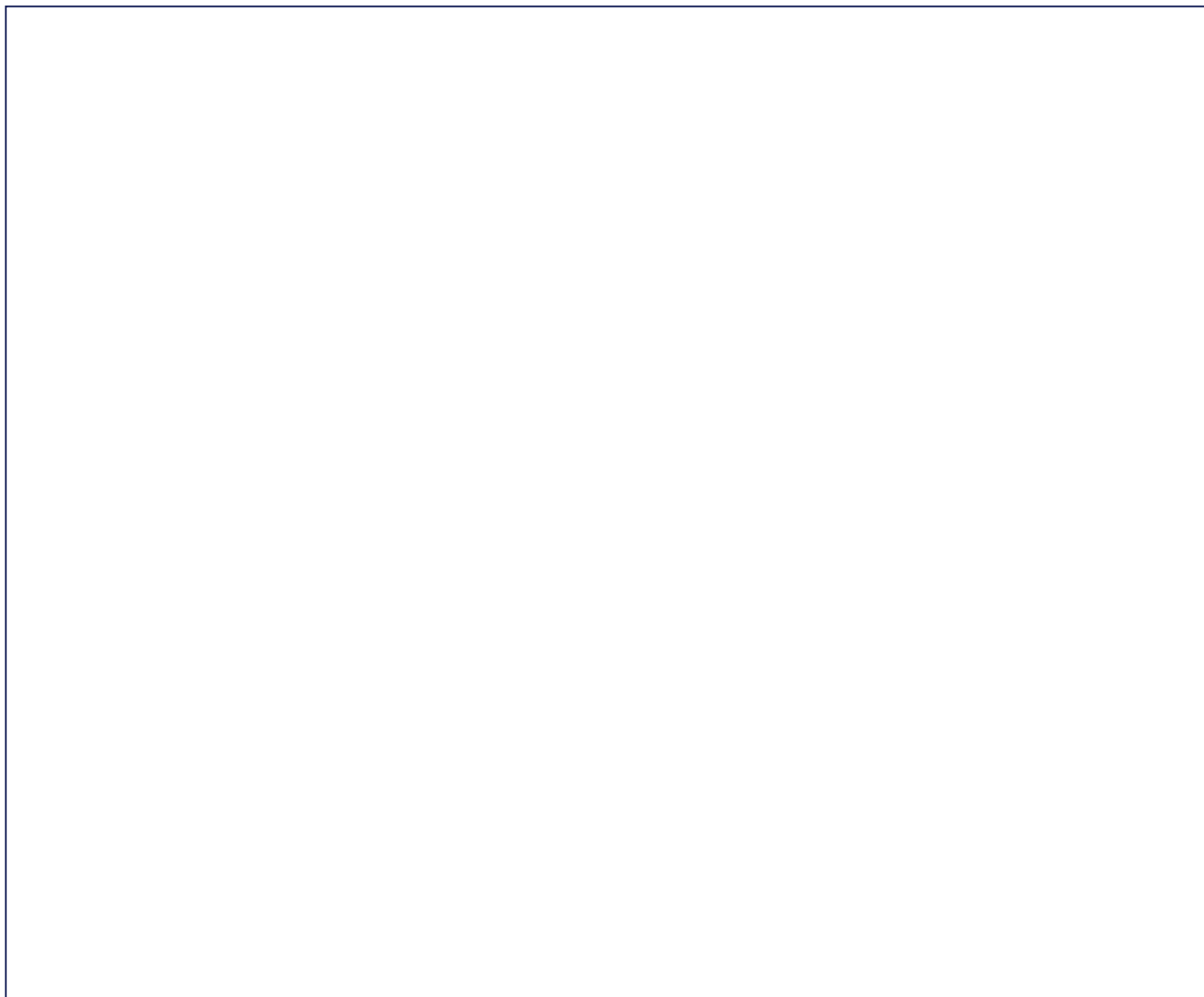


Kit's Data Collection Sheet

Learning objective: To collect and organise data into a simple tally chart and bar chart.

Help Kit the fox count the items found in the forest. Follow the steps below to draw your data charts.

Draw: Draw a clear, neat chart showing Kit the fox sitting in a forest. Draw a tally chart on one side of the paper and a bar chart on the other. Use straight lines with a ruler. Make sure the bars on the bar chart are all the same width and clearly labelled.



Label words: Tally · Frequency · Total · Bar Chart · Data

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a table with three columns. Label them 'Item', 'Tally', and 'Total'.
2. Step 2: Kit found 3 pinecones, 5 acorns, and 2 feathers. Draw the tally marks for these items in your table.
3. Step 3: Draw a bar chart grid. Label the bottom 'Items' and the side 'Number found'.
4. Step 4: Colour in the bars for the pinecones, acorns, and feathers using your data.
