Learning objective: To understand how to stay safe online and recognise the difference between private and public information.

Kit the Fox is helping us stay safe on the internet. Look at the information pieces below. Decide if each piece is 'Safe to Share' (Public) or 'Keep Private' (Personal). Draw a line from the item to the correct box or write 'Safe' or 'Private' next to each one.
