

Staying Safe Online: A Computing Assessment

Learning objective: To show how to stay safe, kind, and responsible when using the internet.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank if you need help. Write your answers clearly on the lines provided.

Kit the fox loves using his tablet to learn new things. He knows that being online is fun, but he always follows three simple rules: keep his secrets safe, be kind to others, and tell a grown-up if something feels wrong.

1. Kit has a secret code to get into his tablet. What is this code called? (2 marks)

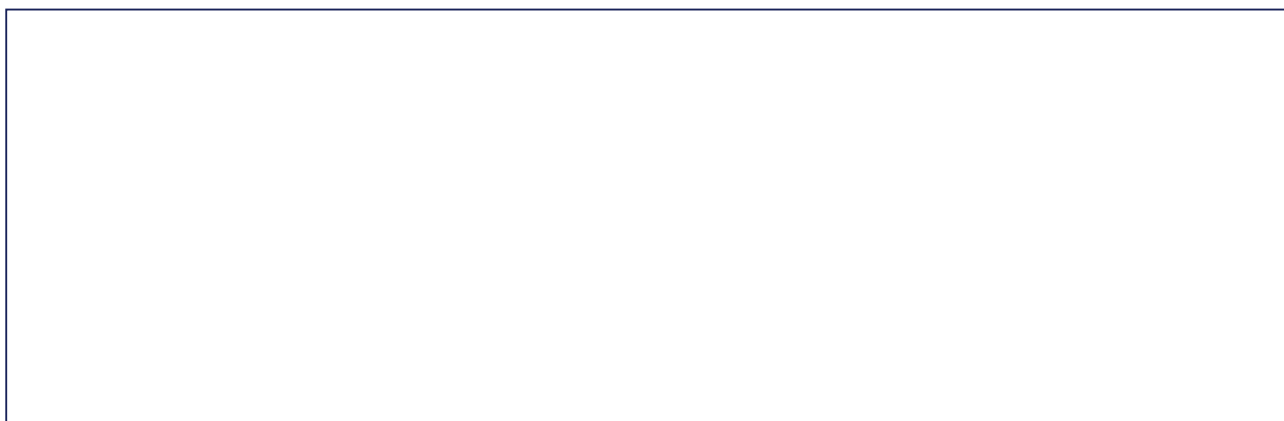
2. Name two pieces of personal information you should never share online. (2 marks)

4. Why is it important to be kind to people when you are playing games or talking online? (4 marks)

5. Imagine you see something online that makes you feel sad or worried. Write a short plan (3 steps) of what you would do to stay safe. (8 marks)
