

Keeping Safe Online with Kit the Fox

Learning objective: To identify ways to stay safe online and understand the importance of keeping personal information private.

Follow the steps below to complete your safety poster. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing. Make your poster bright and colourful!

Draw: Draw a large rectangular screen in the centre of the page. Inside the screen, draw Kit the Fox with a friendly face. Around the outside of the screen, draw symbols of safety like a shield or a padlock. Use bright colours to make the poster look welcoming. Make sure the area for the drawing is large enough for a Year 4 student to add labels clearly.



Label words: Password · Private · Help · Screen · Safe

Steps:

1. Step 1: In the box below, draw Kit the Fox sitting in front of a computer screen. Give Kit a happy smile.
2. Step 2: Draw a shield next to the computer. Label the shield with the word 'Safe'.
3. Step 3: Draw a small padlock on the screen. This reminds us to keep our 'Password' secret.
4. Step 4: Who should you talk to if you see something online that makes you feel worried or sad? Draw a speech bubble for Kit that says: 'I will ask for...'
