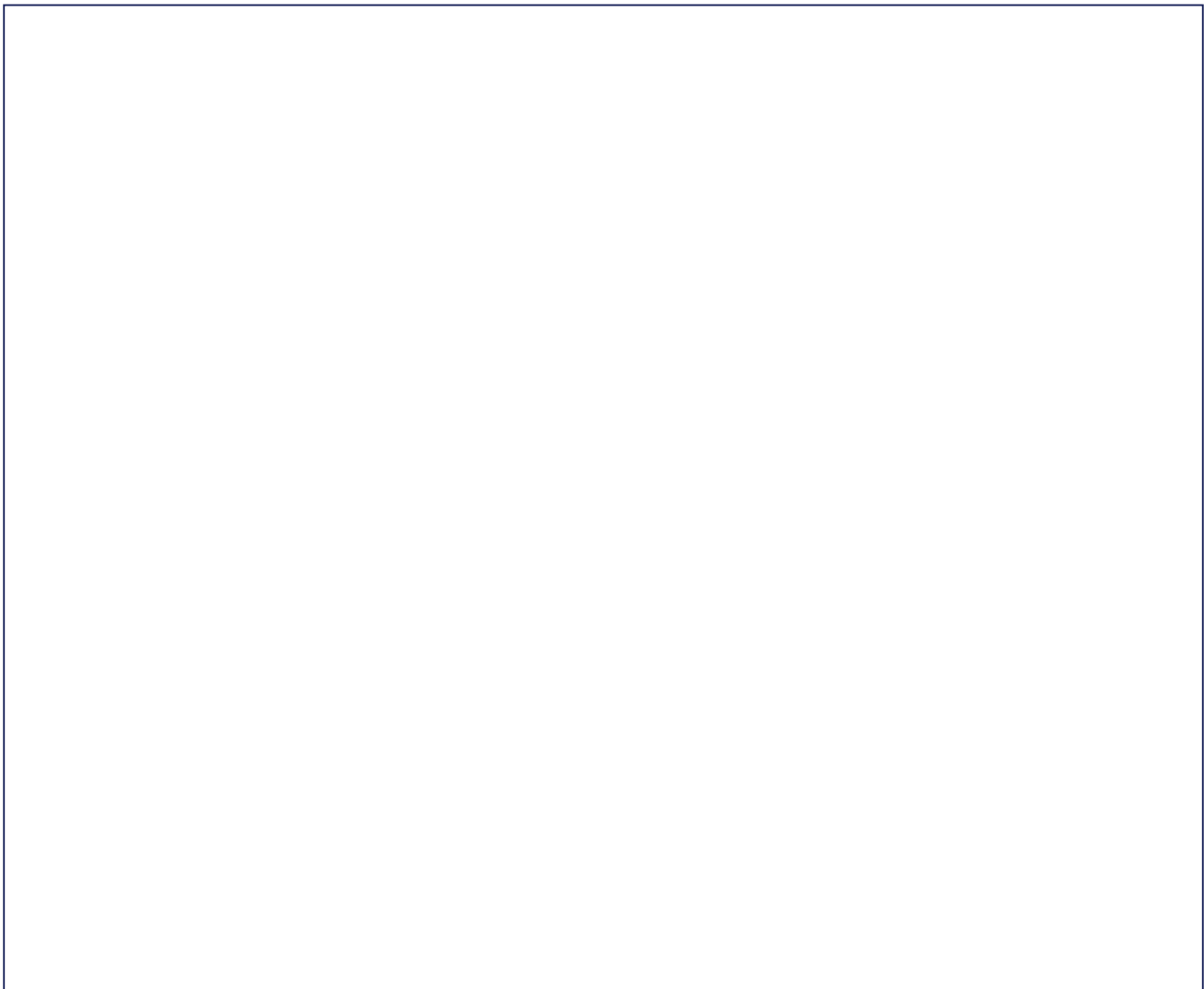


Kit's Guide to Staying Safe Online

Learning objective: To identify how to stay safe and make kind choices when using the internet.

Follow the steps below to create your Internet Safety poster. Use your pencils to draw the scenes and add labels from the word bank.

Draw: Draw a bright, colourful poster featuring Kit the Fox helping a friend use a computer safely. Include a large computer screen in the centre. Show Kit pointing to a 'shield' icon to represent safety. Use clear, thick lines for your drawings and leave space to write the labels from the word bank next to the correct items.



Label words: Private · Kind · Password · Trusted Adult · Screen

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a tablet or computer screen. In the box, write one rule about keeping your password secret.
2. Step 2: Draw a speech bubble coming from Kit the Fox. Write a kind message you could send to a friend online.
3. Step 3: Draw a person standing next to the screen. Label this person as a 'Trusted Adult'.
4. Step 4: Draw a small shield in the corner of your page. Why is it important to keep your home address private?
