6. If someone is being mean to you online, what is this called? A) Cyberbullying*, B) Online gaming, C) Digital chatting, D) Web surfing (1 mark)

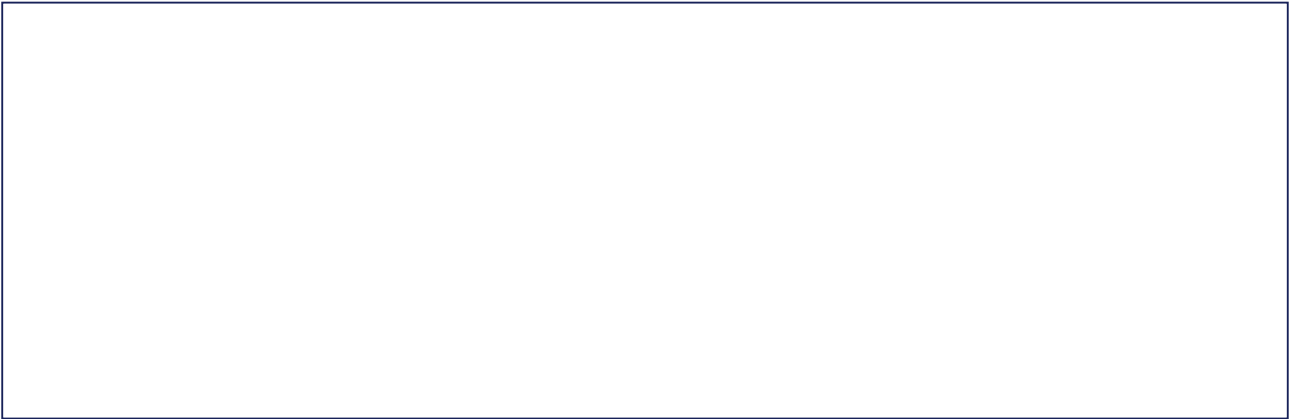
7. True or False: You should always check your privacy settings on social media or gaming platforms to keep your profile private. (1 mark)
