

Kit's Computer Network Adventure

Learning objective: To understand how devices connect to each other in a network.

Follow the steps below to draw a simple network. Use the Word Bank to help you label your drawing. You can use colours to show how the devices connect.

Draw: Draw a clear diagram showing a central box labelled 'Server'. On the left, draw a desktop computer and draw a solid straight line connecting it to the server. On the right, draw a tablet and draw three small curved lines (like a signal icon) between the tablet and the server. Keep your lines neat and use colours to make the connections easy to see.



Label words: Server · Computer · Tablet · Wi-Fi · Cable

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large box in the middle of your page to be the 'Server'. Label it.
2. Step 2: Draw two devices (a computer and a tablet) around the server.
3. Step 3: Draw a straight line from the computer to the server to show a 'Cable'.
4. Step 4: Draw wavy lines between the tablet and the server to show 'Wi-Fi'.
