Get clicking and start coding with Kit the Fox!

- A Sprite is any character or object you choose to add to your project.
- The Stage is the area where your project comes to life and shows your animations.
- A Script is a stack of blocks that tells your sprite how to move or speak.
- Motion blocks are coloured blue and help your sprite move across the stage.
- You can change the look of your project by picking a new Backdrop for your stage.

Did you know? Did you know? Scratch is a type of 'block-based' coding language. This means you don't have to type tricky text codes. Instead, you drag and drop colourful blocks like puzzle pieces to tell your characters what to do!
