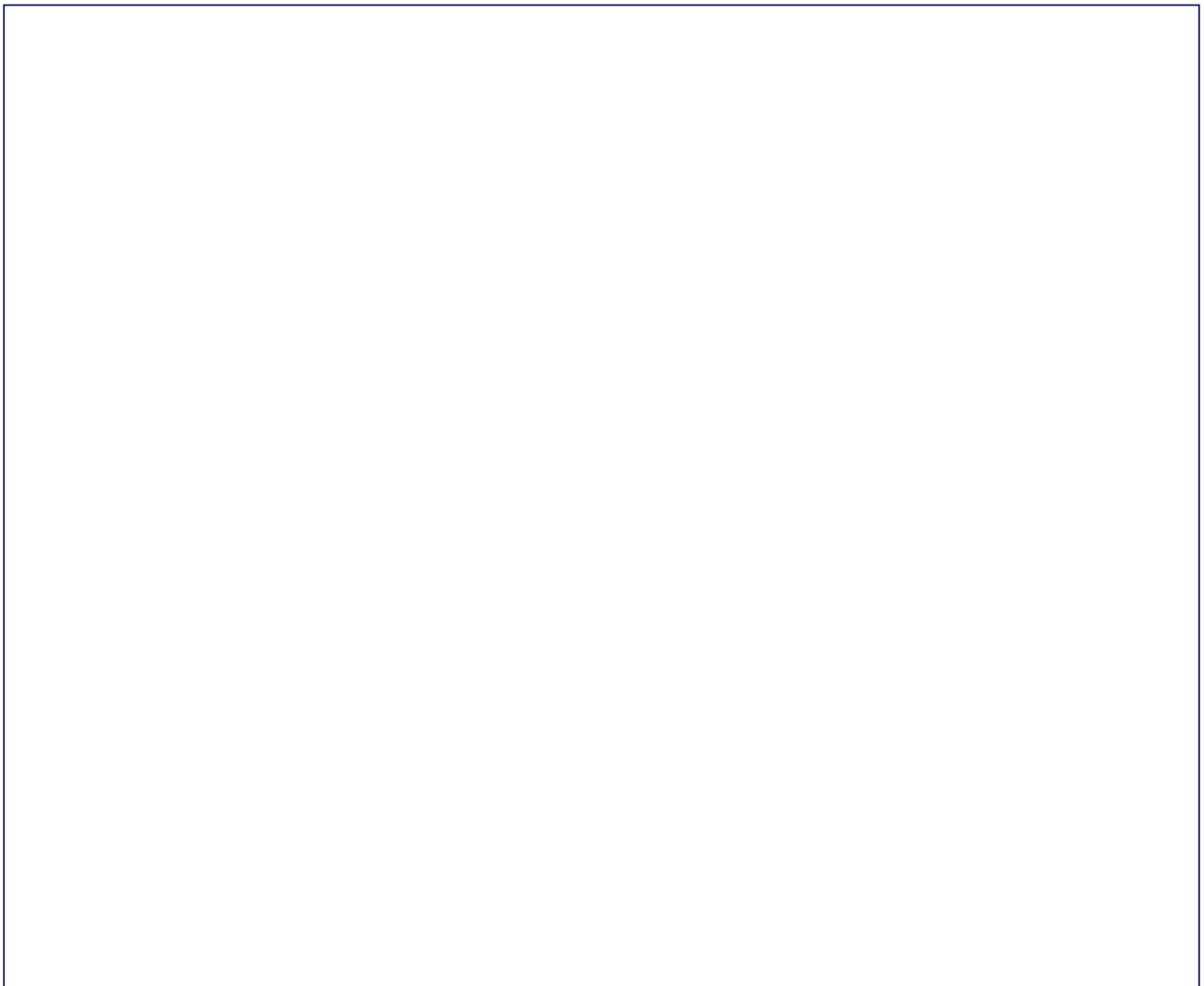


Kit's Spreadsheet Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and label the key parts of a spreadsheet including rows, columns, and cells.

Kit the fox is organising his library collection. Look at the grid below. Follow the instructions to label the parts of the spreadsheet so Kit can find his books easily.

Draw: Draw a large grid on the page, similar to a piece of squared paper. Label the top columns with letters (A, B, C) and the side rows with numbers (1, 2, 3). Draw a small, friendly cartoon fox (Kit) standing next to the grid holding a pencil. Leave plenty of white space inside the grid boxes for the student to write in.



Label words: Column · Row · Cell · Data

Steps:

1. Look at the vertical line of letters. Draw an arrow to one and label it a 'Column'.
2. Look at the horizontal line of numbers. Draw an arrow to one and label it a 'Row'.
3. Draw a small box where a row and column meet. Label this a 'Cell'.
4. Kit has 5 books. Write the number '5' inside one of the cells to show his data.
