- A spreadsheet is a digital grid made up of little boxes called cells.
- The vertical lines of boxes are called columns, and the horizontal lines are called rows.
- You can type numbers or words into any cell to save your information.
- A formula is a special instruction that tells the computer to do maths for you, like adding up costs in £.
- Spreadsheets help us sort information quickly so we can spot patterns easily.
