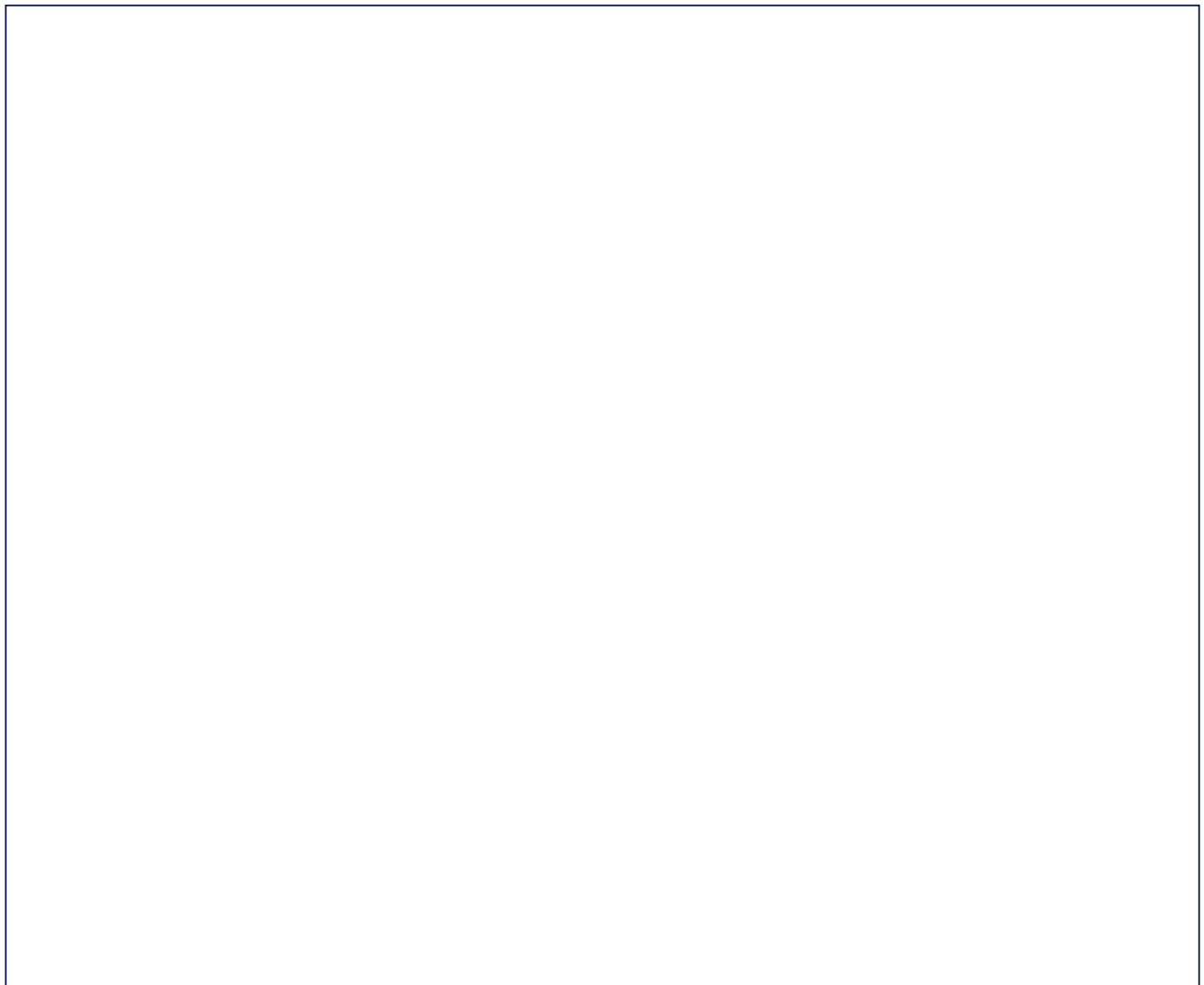


Max's Seasonal Food Garden

Learning objective: To identify and draw seasonal foods grown in the UK and understand why we eat them at different times of the year.

Max the monkey is planning a healthy lunch! He wants to use foods that grow in the UK during the summer. Follow the steps below to help Max design his garden harvest.

Draw: Draw a large, clear picture of a wicker basket sitting in a garden. Inside and around the basket, draw bright red strawberries, green pea pods, and crisp green lettuce leaves. In the top corner of the page, draw a large yellow sun. Use bright colours and keep your labels neat so Max can read them easily.



Label words: strawberries · peas · lettuce · cucumber · sun · basket

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a basket in the middle of your page. Label the basket.
2. Step 2: Draw three types of summer vegetables inside or next to the basket. Label them using the word bank.
3. Step 3: Draw a bright sun in the corner to show it is summer. Label the sun.
4. Step 4: Write one sentence about why we should eat food grown in the UK. Start with: 'We eat seasonal food because...'
