1. Zara has a blanket. It feels like a cloud. It is a _____ blanket. (2 marks)

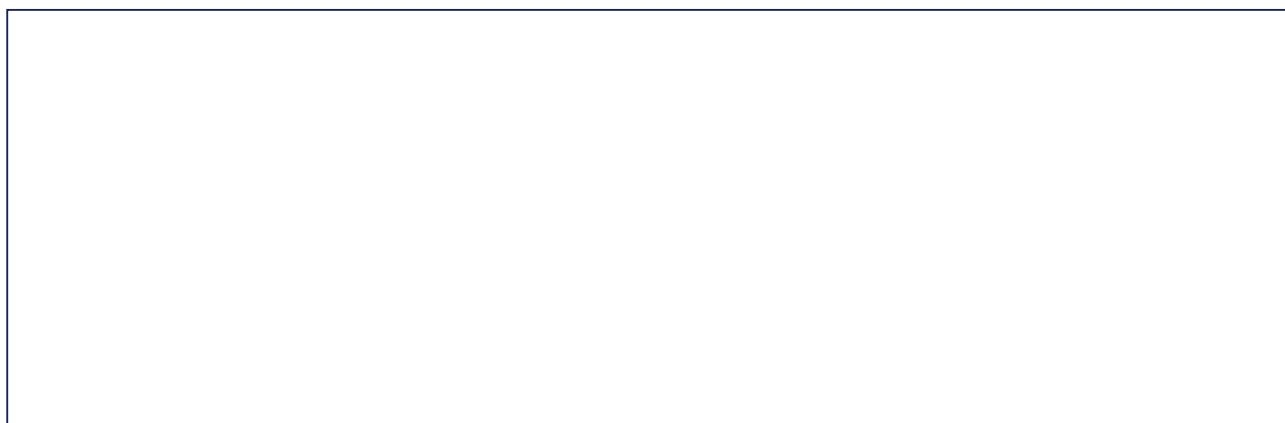
2. Zara finds a pebble from the river. It feels rough and has lots of little lumps. It is a _____ pebble. (2 marks)
