

Zara's Colourful Garden Adventures

Learning objective: To identify and use adjectives to describe objects, people, and places.

Help Zara the Zebra make her garden look beautiful! Read the words in the word bank and draw them into the garden scene. Think of one more adjective to describe your favourite thing you have drawn.

Draw: A large, open garden scene featuring Zara the Zebra standing on the left. The rest of the page is a blank space with a simple patch of grass at the bottom and a sunny sky at the top. The style should be clean, friendly, and inviting for children to add their own illustrations using crayons or pencils.



Label words: sparkly · giant · soft · bright · tiny · fluffy

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a giant flower in the middle of the garden. How does it smell?
2. Step 2: Draw a tiny, sparkly butterfly near the flower. What colour is it?
3. Step 3: Label your giant flower using one word from the word bank.
4. Step 4: Draw a fluffy cloud in the sky. If you could touch the cloud, what would it feel like?
5. Step 5: Zara wants to buy a pot for £2. Can you draw the pot and write the price tag on it?
