

Max the Monkey's Adjective Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and use adjectives to describe nouns in sentences.

Read the story about Max the Monkey. Look at the words in the box to help you describe the things Max finds in the jungle.

Max the Monkey is looking for his lost fruit basket. He swings through the jungle. First, he spots a yellow banana. It has a smooth skin. Then, he finds a rock that feels very rough. Max climbs a tall tree to look for his basket. He sees a colourful bird sitting on a branch. Max is happy when he finally finds his basket hidden behind a big leaf.

Word bank: shiny · fuzzy · giant · bumpy · sweet · bright

1. Find an adjective in the text that describes the banana. Write it here. (1 mark)

2. The text says the tree is 'tall'. What is another adjective from the word bank that could describe a tree? (1 mark)

3. Max found a rock. How did the rock feel? Use a word from the text. (1 mark)

4. Write a sentence using one adjective from the word bank to describe a piece of fruit. (2 marks)

5. Can you think of a new adjective to describe Max the Monkey? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw Max the Monkey holding a piece of fruit. Label your drawing using two adjectives from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Think of three adjectives to describe your favourite toy. Write them in a list and then put them into a full sentence.
