

Adjective Adventures with Max the Monkey

Learning objective: To identify and use adjectives to describe nouns.

Max the Monkey is looking for things to count! Help him describe the objects he finds by choosing the best adjectives from the word bank.

Max the Monkey is exploring the forest. He sees a [blank] apple. He finds a [blank] cloud. He counts a [blank] pebble. He spots a [blank] star. He climbs a [blank] tree. He holds a [blank] leaf.

Word bank: shiny · fluffy · bumpy · gigantic · tiny · bright

1. 1. What is an adjective? Circle the correct answer: A word that tells us what something is doing OR A word that describes a noun. (1 mark)

2. 2. Max found a strawberry. Write one adjective to describe it. (1 mark)

3. 3. Look at the word bank. Write a sentence using the adjective 'shiny'. (2 marks)

4. 4. Draw a line to match the noun to a good adjective:

Elephant --- Soft

Feather --- Heavy

Rock --- Grey (3 marks)

5. 5. Max found two coins worth 5p each. Write a sentence describing the coins using an adjective. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw Max the Monkey holding a piece of fruit. Label your drawing using at least two adjectives (e.g., 'a yellow banana' or 'a round fruit').



Extension challenge: Can you find three objects in your classroom? Write them down and think of two adjectives for each object!
