

Max the Monkey's Adventurous Adverbs

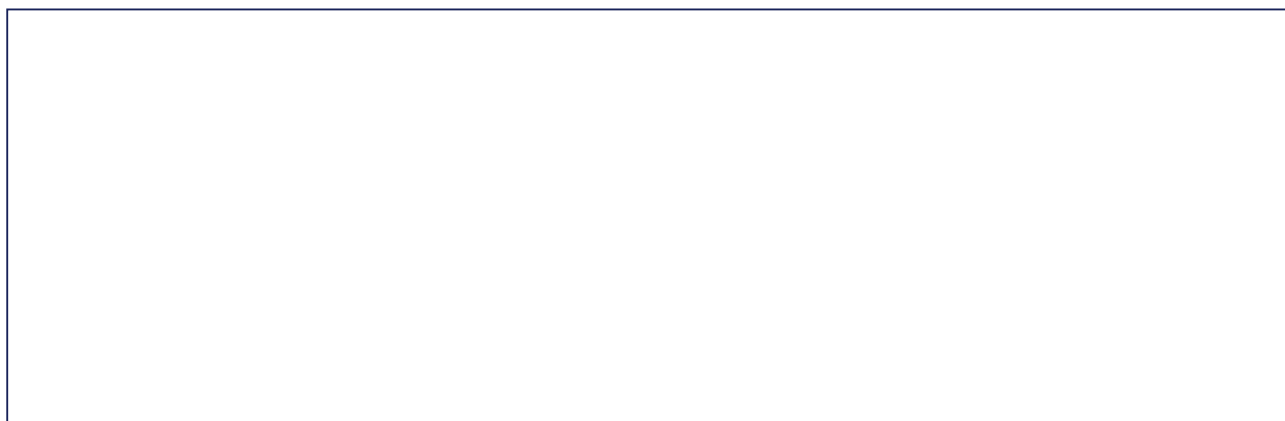
Learning objective: To identify and use adverbs to describe how actions are performed.
