Add a dash of sparkle to your sentences with Adverbs!

- An adverb tells us more about a verb. It explains how, when, or where an action is happening.
- If you are running, you might run 'fast', 'slowly', or 'happily'. These are all adverbs!
- Adverbs help the reader picture the scene. Instead of saying 'Max climbed', you could say 'Max climbed carefully'.
- Look for the '-ly' ending. Words like 'softly', 'loudly', and 'brightly' are common adverbs in our stories.
- Adverbs are like the secret ingredients in a recipe; they make your writing much more exciting to read!

Did you know? Did you know? Many adverbs are formed by adding the suffix '-ly' to an adjective. If a monkey is 'quick', he moves 'quickly'! Always look for the action word (the verb) first, then ask yourself how it happened.
