4. 4. Change these adjectives into adverbs by adding '-ly'. Example: quick -> quickly.

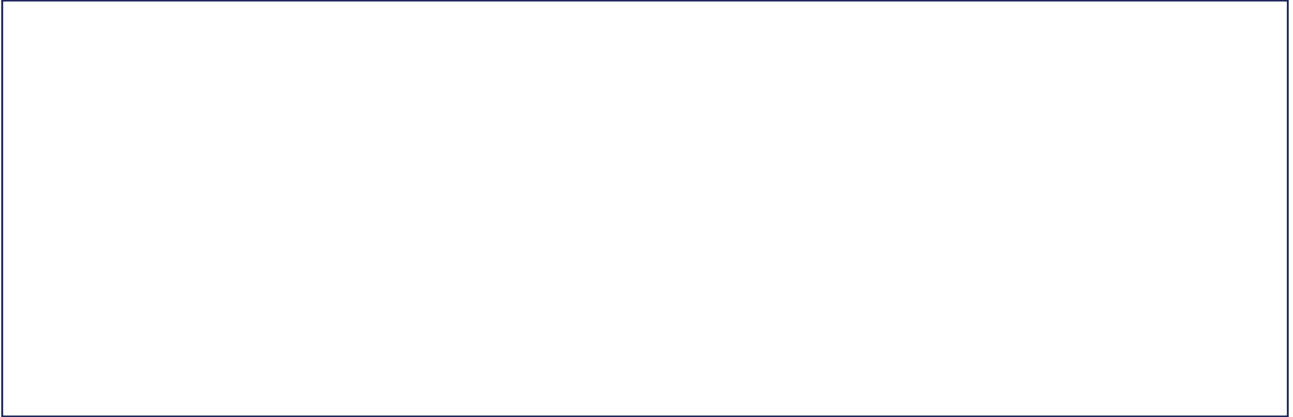
