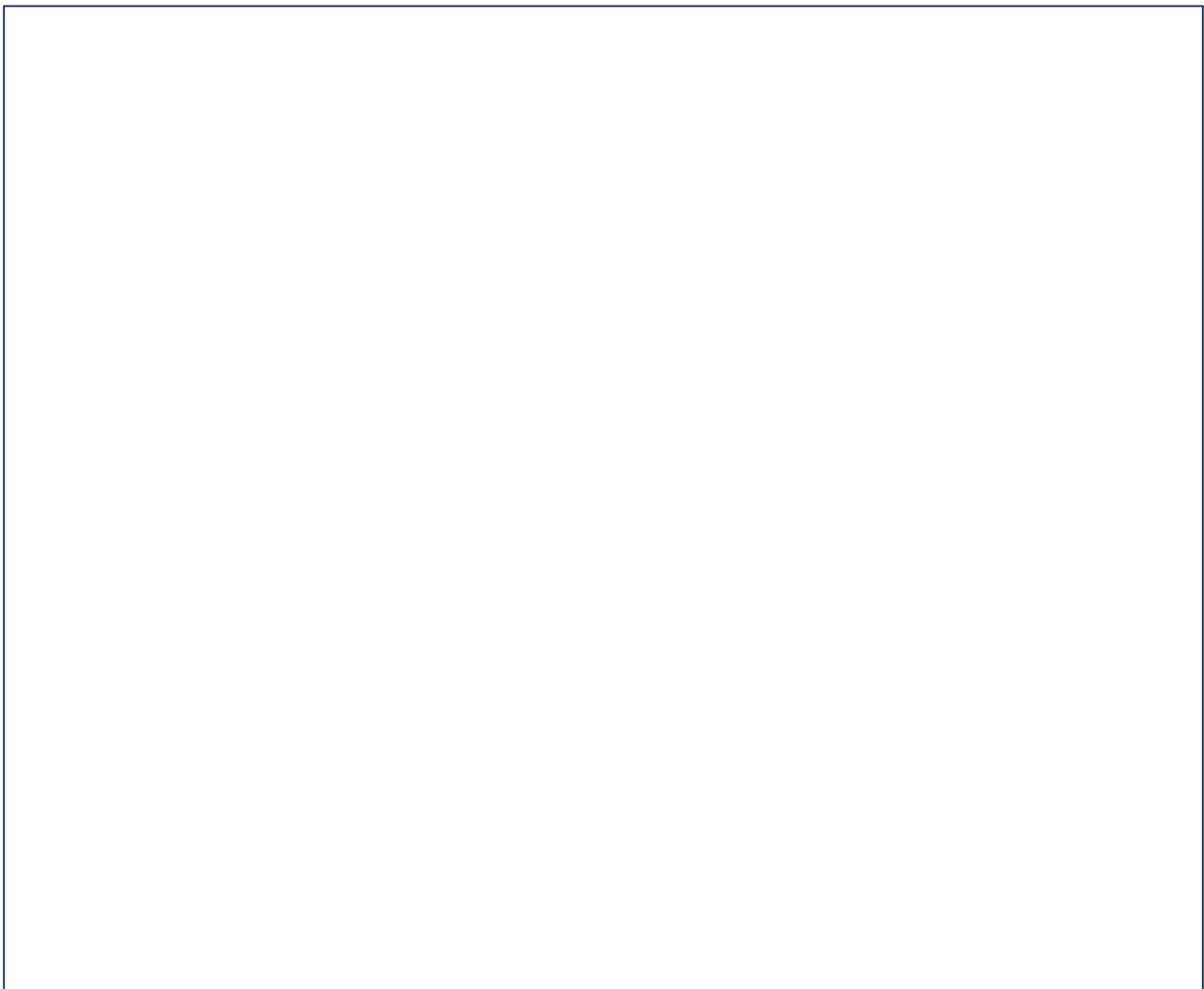


Mapping a Life Story: Biography Illustration

Learning objective: To visually represent the key stages and significant achievements of a person's life in preparation for writing a biography.

Think about the life of an inspirational figure. In the space provided, draw a 'Life Timeline Map'. Use images to represent their childhood, their biggest challenge, and their greatest achievement. Use the word bank to label the different sections of your drawing.

Draw: Create a visual timeline in a cartoon-sketch style. The scene should show a winding path that travels from the bottom left corner to the top right corner of the page. Include icons along the path: a small house for childhood, a jagged rock for an obstacle, and a bright, shining star for an achievement. Leave enough white space around the drawings to add labels from the word bank.



Label words: Early Life · Turning Point · Major Achievement · Legacy · Inspiration · Obstacle

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a winding path across the page. At the start of the path, draw a symbol representing the person's childhood. Label this 'Early Life'.
2. Step 2: Draw a mountain or a large rock in the middle of the path to represent a challenge they faced. Label this 'Obstacle'.

3. Step 3: At the end of the path, draw a star or a trophy to show their greatest success. Label this 'Major Achievement'.
4. Step 4: Choose one item from the word bank that describes why this person is remembered today and write a short sentence explaining your choice next to your drawing.
5. Step 5: Write down two chronological time-markers (e.g., 'In 1920' or 'During their teenage years') that show when these events happened.
