Then, put them in order from the earliest person to the most recent by writing the numbers 1, 2, 3, and 4 in the boxes.

1. 1. Mary Seacole: She was a nurse who travelled to help soldiers. (Match: A, B, C, or D) (2 marks)

3. 3. Rosa Parks: She showed great courage and helped change unfair laws in America. (Match: A, B, C, or D) (2 marks)

4. 4. Sir Lewis Hamilton: He is a champion racing driver who works hard to make sport fairer for everyone. (Match: A, B, C, or D) (2 marks)

5. Challenge: Why is it important to remember the stories of people who made the world a better place? (2 marks)
