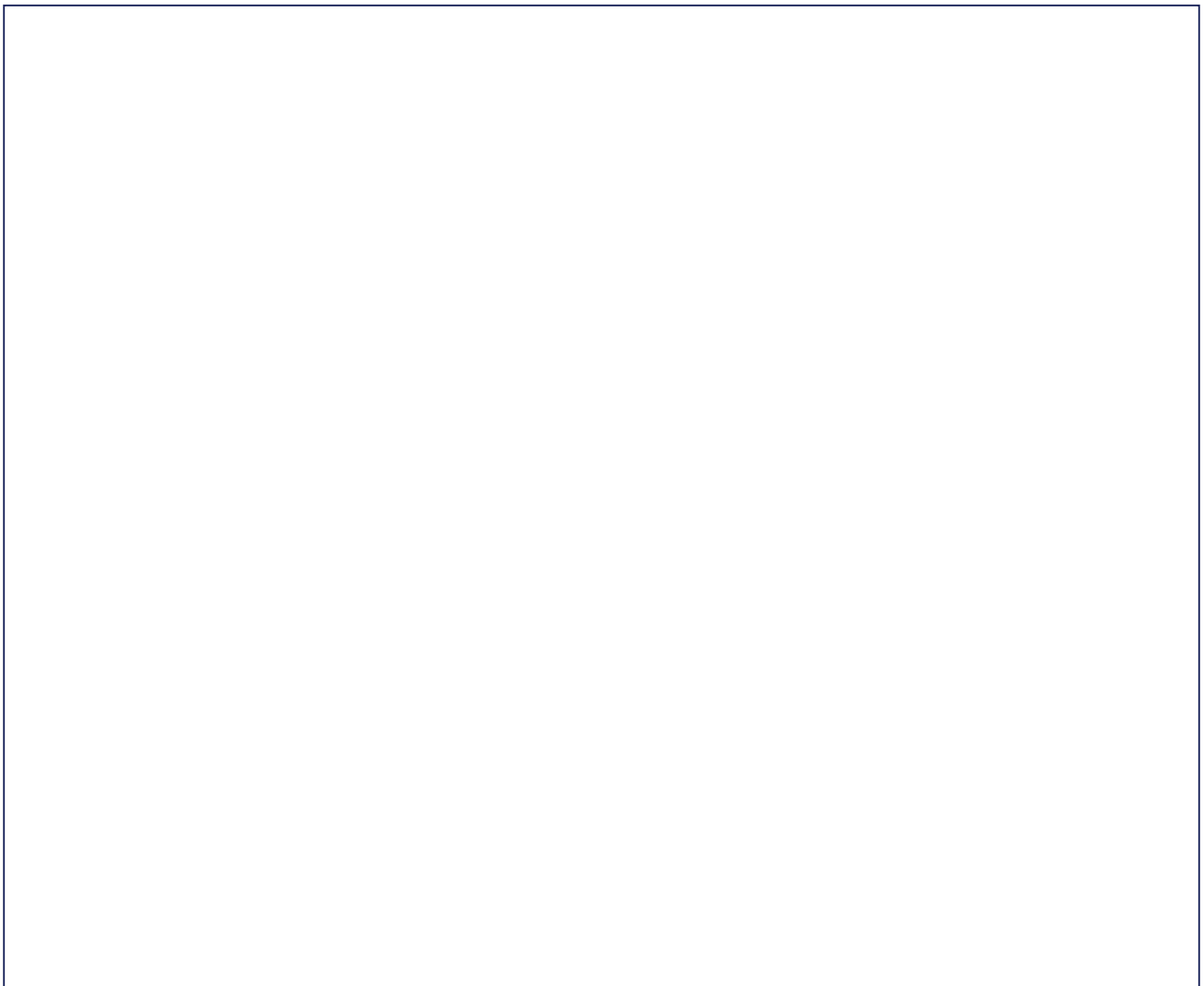


A Bright Night with Nova

Learning objective: To use descriptive vocabulary and imaginative drawing to recount the sights and sounds of Bonfire Night.

Nova the owl is watching the night sky. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing and describe the scene in the spaces provided.

Draw: Draw a night scene featuring a large, dark sky. In the centre, draw a big, colourful firework bursting with patterns. Include Nova the owl perched on a tree branch in the corner, looking up with wide, curious eyes. Add some smaller, glowing sparkles around the main firework. Use bright colours like yellow, red, and blue against the dark background.



Label words: sparkling · bright · crackle · pop · glow · night sky · firework · colours

Steps:

1. Nova sees a firework that looks like a giant star. Describe its colour and shape in one sentence.
2. What sound does the firework make when it bursts? Use a word from the bank.
3. Draw a line to match the word 'sparkling' to a part of your drawing.
4. Why do we see the fireworks clearly in the night sky? Write one reason.
5. If you could design your own firework, what shape would it be?
