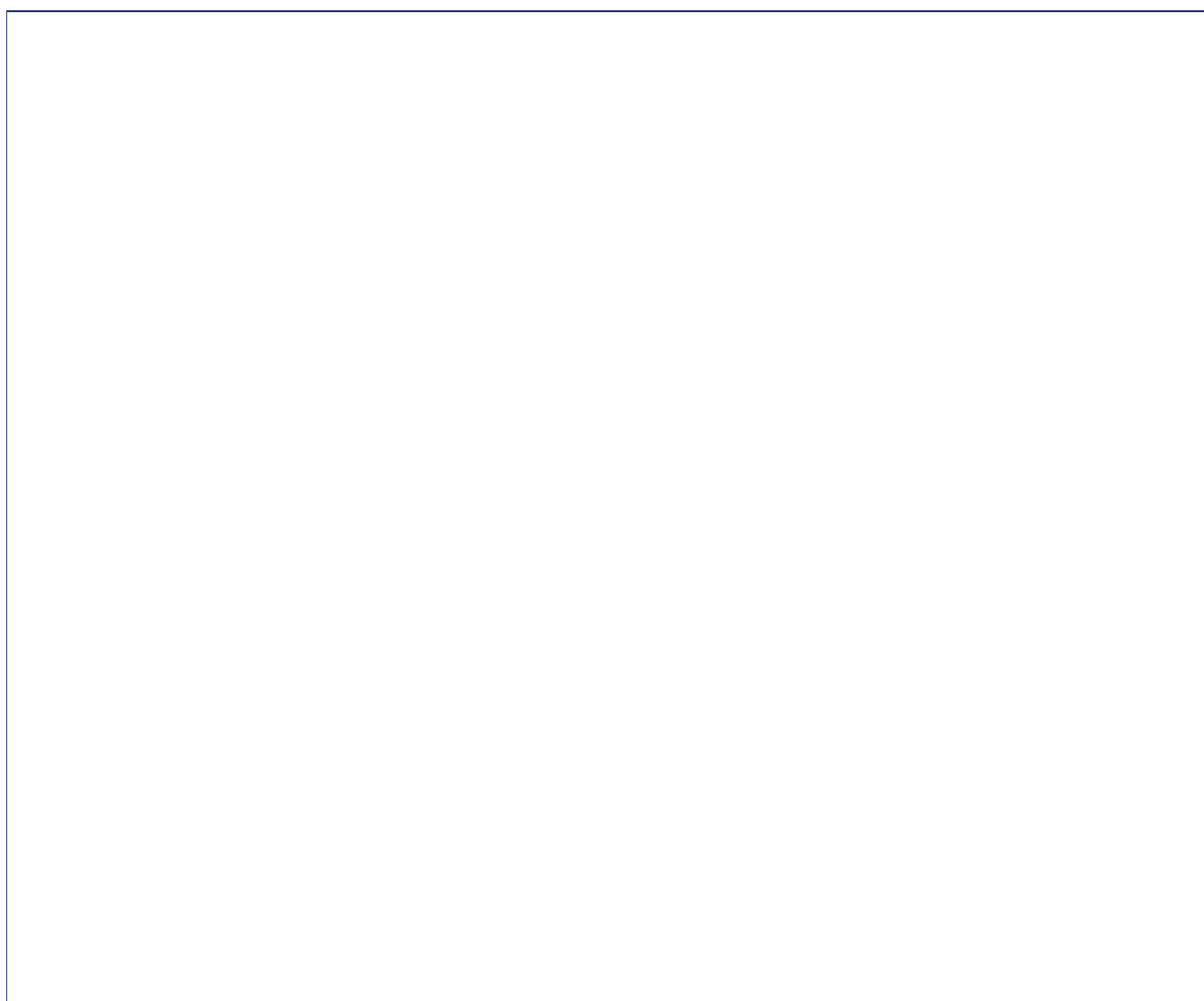


Bonfire Night with Max and Zara

Learning objective: To use descriptive vocabulary and visual representation to illustrate a seasonal event while practicing labelling skills.

Follow the drawing prompt below to create your own Bonfire Night scene. Use the word bank to label your picture, then answer the questions to explain your artistic choices.

Draw: Draw a nighttime landscape. In the centre, draw a large, bright bonfire with orange, yellow, and red flames. Around the bonfire, draw Max the monkey and Zara the zebra looking up at the sky. Above them, draw at least three different shaped fireworks bursting in the dark sky. Use bright, vibrant colours for the fireworks and dark colours for the background to make your drawing pop. Add labels to your drawing using the words from the word bank.



Label words: sparkler · bonfire · flames · night sky · firework · glow · crackle

Steps:

1. Which colours did you choose to use for your fireworks and why?
2. Describe the sound of the bonfire using an onomatopoeia word.
3. If Max and Zara were standing near the bonfire, how would they feel? (e.g., warm, excited, noisy)
4. Find a word from the word bank that describes how the fire looks and write it here.

5. Why do we celebrate Bonfire Night in the UK? Write one short sentence.
