

Pip's Book Review Adventure

Learning objective: To express personal preferences about a book and explain why using descriptive language.

Help Pip the bookworm caterpillar tell others about a story you have read! Think about your favourite part and draw a picture to show what happened.

Pip has just finished reading a wonderful new book. Now, Pip wants to tell all of his friends what he thought about it. When we write a book review, we share our ideas and say what we enjoyed most about the story.

1. What is the title of the book you have just read? (1 mark)

2. Who was your favourite character in the story and why? (2 marks)

3. Did you like the book? Circle one: Yes / No. Tell me one reason why. (2 marks)

4. If you could change one thing in the story, what would it be? (2 marks)

5. Would you tell a friend to read this book? Why? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of the most exciting part of the book in the box below. Make sure to draw the main character!



Extension challenge: Imagine you are the author. If you were going to write a sequel (the next part of the story), what would happen next? Tell your teacher or a partner your idea.
