1. 1. What is the title of the book you are reviewing? (1 mark)

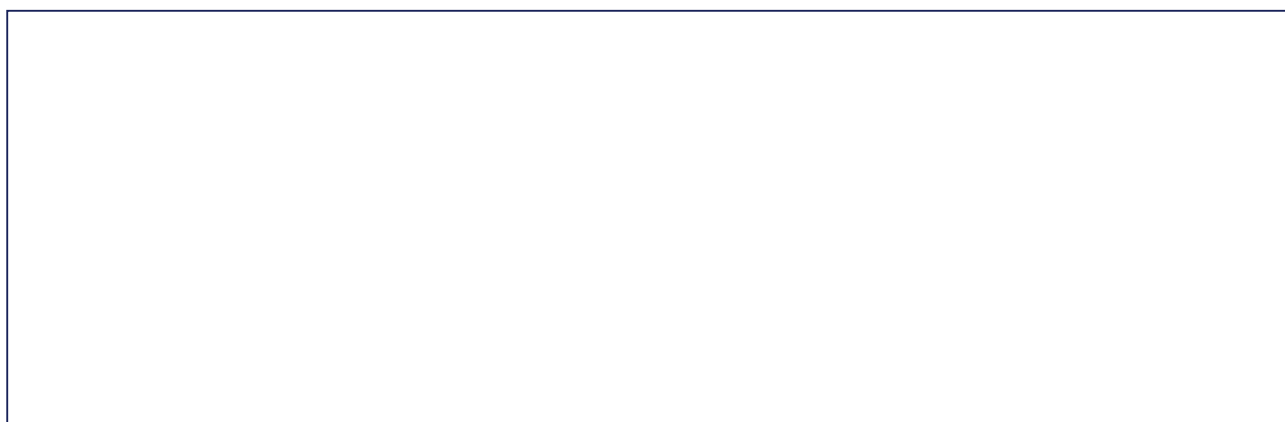
2. 2. My _____ character in this book was _____ because they were very _____. (2 marks)
