Learning objective: To write a clear and persuasive book review using descriptive adjectives and personal opinions.

Read the book review written by Pip the caterpillar. Use the passage to help you answer the questions below. Remember to use full sentences and your best joined-up handwriting.

Last week, I finished reading a wonderful story called 'The Forest of Whispering Leaves'. It is about a brave squirrel named Squeak who loses his favourite golden acorn. The plot is very exciting because Squeak has to travel across the river and climb the highest oak tree to find it. My favourite character is Squeak because he is so determined. 1. Who is the main character in the story Pip read? (1 mark)

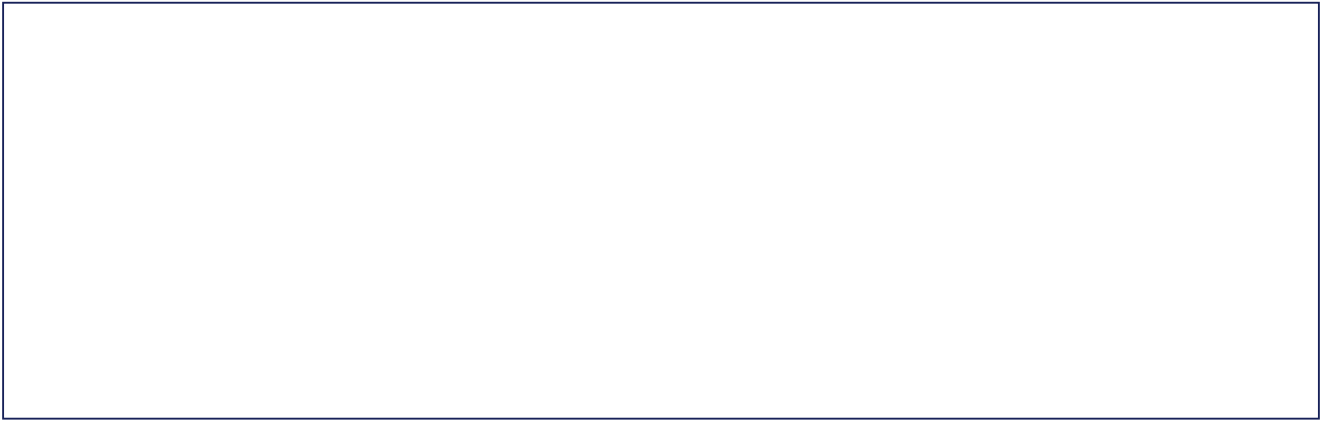
2. Why does Pip think the plot is exciting? Use evidence from the text. (2 marks)

4. Who would Pip recommend this book to? (1 mark)

5. If you were writing a review, what is one thing you would include to tell a friend if a book is good? (2 marks)
