

Drawing My Character: Max the Maths Monkey

Learning objective: To use descriptive adjectives to label and draw a character, focusing on appearance and personality.

Follow the steps below to draw Max the Monkey. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing with interesting adjectives.

Draw: Draw a friendly monkey in the centre of the page. He should have a long tail and be holding a small notebook. Use clear lines and bright colours. Around the monkey, draw small shapes like triangles, circles, and stars to represent the maths patterns he loves.



Label words: cheerful · clever · bright · furry · curly · helpful · tiny · busy

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw Max the Monkey in the box. Give him a big smile.
2. Step 2: Draw Max holding his favourite notepad. Label the notepad using a word from the bank.
3. Step 3: Write two sentences to describe Max. Use the sentence starter: Max is a... He has...
4. Step 4: Draw a maths pattern (like a circle or a star) next to Max to show he is a clever mathematician.
