

Zara's Story Spinner

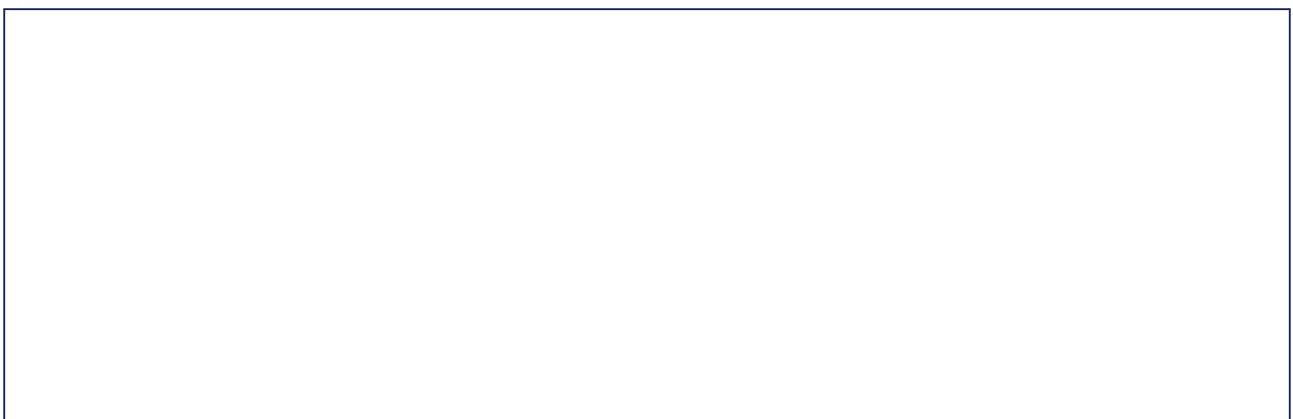
Learning objective: To develop narrative structure by sequencing a simple story using character, setting, and event prompts.
