

Adventures with Max the Monkey: Writing Super Sentences

Learning objective: To use adjectives and descriptive language to write exciting sentences about an adventure.

Max the Monkey is planning a jungle adventure! Help him write his story by using the word bank to add detail. Remember to use a capital letter at the start of your sentence and a full stop at the end.

Max the monkey is getting ready for a trip. He wants to find the secret treasure hidden in the jungle. He needs your help to describe what he sees on his way!

Word bank: bumpy · sparkly · gigantic · delicious · shimmering · noisy · fluffy · bright

1. Max sees a tree. Write a sentence describing the tree using one word from the word bank. (2 marks)

2. Max finds a piece of fruit. Use an adjective to describe how the fruit tastes. (2 marks)

3. Look at the word 'noisy'. Write a sentence about a noisy animal Max might meet in the jungle. (2 marks)

4. Max finds a hidden treasure box. Describe what the treasure looks like using two adjectives. (2 marks)

5. Why is it important to use a full stop at the end of your sentence? Tell Max your answer. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the Monkey discovering a secret treasure in the jungle. Make sure you draw the things you described in your sentences!



Extension challenge: Can you write a short story of three sentences about what happens when Max finally opens the treasure box? Try to include a word that describes a feeling, like 'happy' or 'surprised'.
