

Max the Monkey's Magical Treehouse Adventure

Learning objective: To use descriptive language and adjectives to create a detailed scene for a story setting.

Max is designing a secret treehouse! Help him finish his plan by drawing the scene and labelling the key features. Use your best descriptive words from the word bank to help bring the drawing to life.

Draw: Draw a large, detailed treehouse nestled in a big oak tree. Include a winding staircase or ladder leading up to it. Add some cozy interior details like shelves for books or a small desk for Max. Use bright colours for the leaves and the treehouse walls to make the scene look vibrant.



Label words: enormous · twinkling · cozy · winding · sturdy · vibrant · canopy · shelves

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw the treehouse in the centre of the page. Make sure it looks sturdy and high up in the branches.
2. Step 2: Label three parts of your treehouse using at least one adjective from the word bank (e.g., 'The sturdy ladder').
3. Step 3: Draw Max the monkey inside the treehouse. What is he holding? Write a sentence below describing his activity.
4. Step 4: Think of one more adjective to describe the weather outside the treehouse and add it to your

drawing.

5. Step 5: If Max wanted to buy a new telescope for his treehouse, and it cost £5, how many £1 coins would he need?
