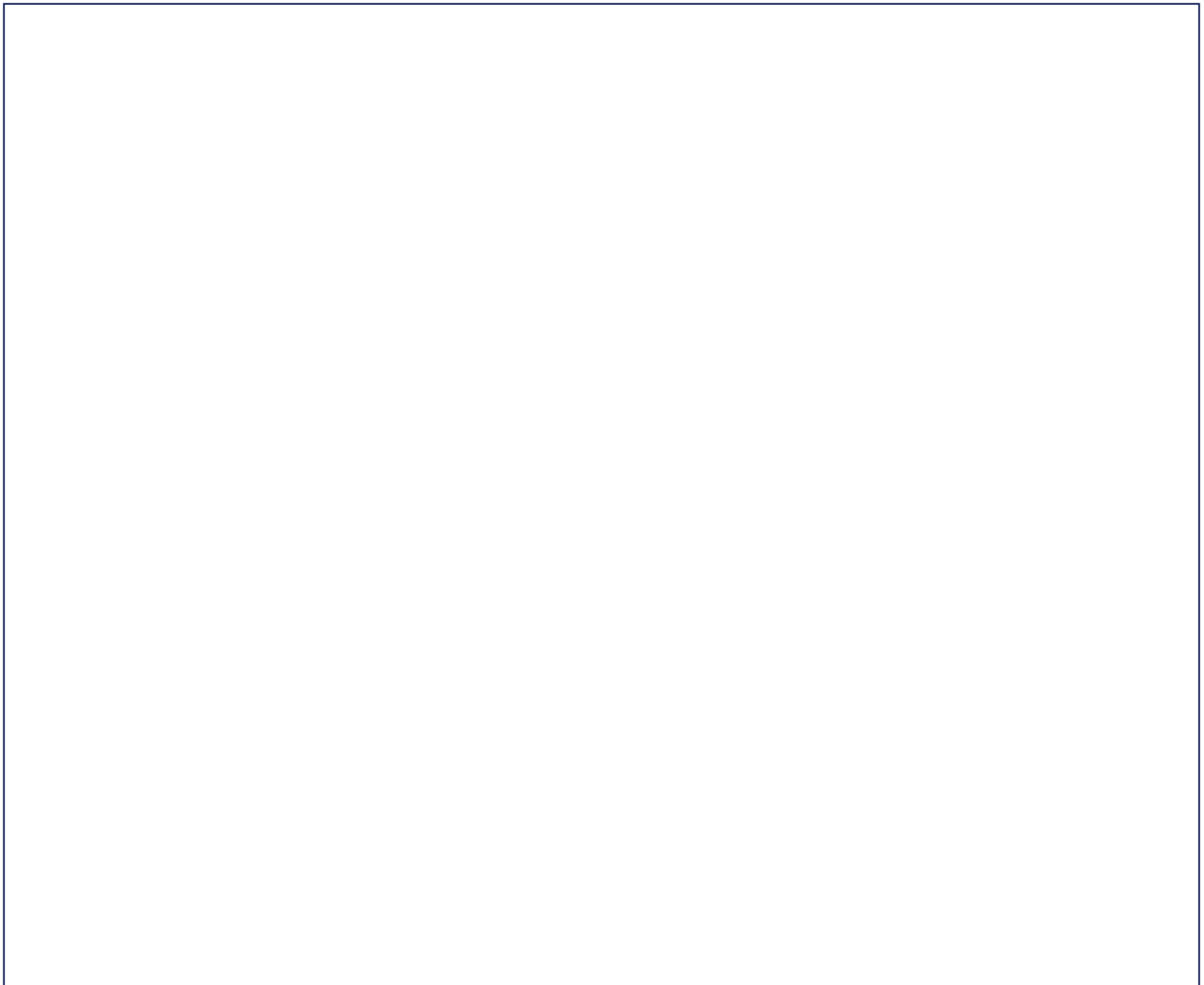


Ellie's Easter Story Scene

Learning objective: To recount the traditional Easter story through illustration and vocabulary usage.

Follow the steps below to draw a scene that helps tell the Easter story. Use your imagination to colour your picture and add as much detail as you can. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a peaceful garden scene. The style should be bright and colourful, reflecting the joy of spring. Include a large, circular stone rolled to one side of a dark cave entrance. Fill the garden with springtime details like tulips, daisies, and golden sunlight shining from the top corner of the page. Use your pencils or felt-tip pens to make the scene look warm and inviting.



Label words: tomb · garden · stone · sunlight · flowers · peaceful

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, round stone sitting in front of the entrance to a cave (the tomb) in the corner of your page.
2. Step 2: Draw bright, colourful flowers growing all around the garden to show that it is springtime.
3. Step 3: Label three items in your drawing using the words from the word bank.
4. Step 4: Write one sentence to describe how the garden feels in your drawing. Is it quiet? Is it bright?
5. Step 5: If you were visiting this garden, what sounds might you hear? Write down two sounds.
