

Pip's Springtime Sequencing Challenge

Learning objective: To sequence the main events of the Easter story using chronological order.

Pip the caterpillar is helping to put the story of Easter in the right order. Read the five sentences below. Number them from 1 to 5 to show the correct order that they happen in the story. Start with 1 for the beginning and 5 for the end.

Word bank: Spring · Easter · Sunday · Friday · Garden · Friends · Hope

1. The people gather together for a special meal with their friends. (1 mark)
2. On a sad Friday, the story tells us about a difficult time for the main character. (1 mark)
3. Everything is quiet and still in the garden for one day. (1 mark)
4. On Sunday morning, there is a feeling of great surprise and joy. (1 mark)
5. The story ends with a message of hope and new life in the spring. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of a garden in spring with colourful flowers to show the feeling of new life.



Extension challenge: Write one sentence about why spring is a good time to think about new beginnings. Start your sentence with: 'I think spring is special because...'
