

# Max's Magnificent Expanded Noun Phrases Quiz

*Learning objective: To identify and create expanded noun phrases to add detail and description to writing.*

Max the monkey is busy counting the details in the rainforest! Read the questions carefully and use your knowledge of adjectives and prepositional phrases to help him describe his jungle home. Each correct answer is worth 1 mark.

Answer Key: 1.C, 2.A, 3.True, 4.B, 5.C, 6.False, 7.The, 8.glistening, 9.True, 10.A. (Explanation: An expanded noun phrase adds extra information to a noun using adjectives or prepositional phrases).
