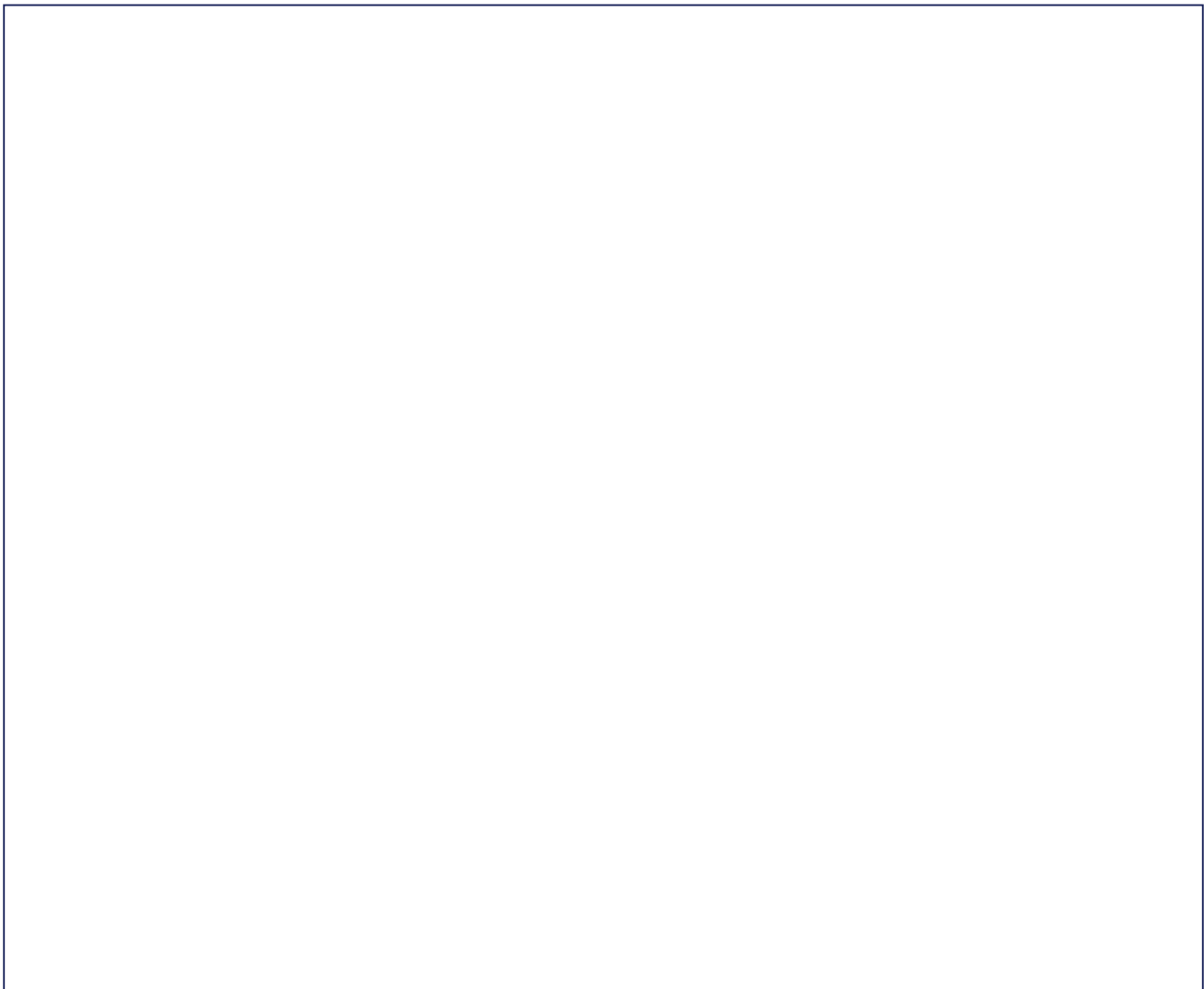


How a Honeybee Makes Honey: A Diagram Sheet

Learning objective: To understand the structure of an explanation text by creating a labelled diagram.

Follow the steps below to draw your diagram. Use the word bank to help you label the important parts of the process.

Draw: Draw a bright, sunny garden scene. On the left, draw a large flower with Bea the honeybee hovering over it. Use an arrow to show the bee flying to the right. On the right, draw a hive with a cut-away section showing a honeycomb pattern inside. Use clear, simple shapes and bright colours.



Label words: Nectar · Flower · Honeycomb · Pollen · Bea · Hive

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw Bea the honeybee landing on a large, bright flower. Label the flower and the bee.
2. Step 2: Draw an arrow from the flower to a hexagon-shaped box. Label this box 'Honeycomb'.
3. Step 3: Draw a large rectangle around the honeycomb to show it is inside the 'Hive'. Label the hive.
4. Step 4: Write one sentence under your drawing to explain what the bee is carrying.
