

Max's Adventure Diary

Learning objective: To use fronted adverbials to describe time, place, and manner in a diary entry.

Max the monkey is going on a jungle maths hunt! Help him write his diary entry. Start your sentences with a fronted adverbial to tell us when, where, or how things happen. Remember to put a comma after your fronted adverbial.

Word bank: Quietly · In the forest · Yesterday morning · Suddenly · Under the big tree · Carefully · At the top of the hill · Happily

1. When did Max start his adventure? (Start with a time adverbial like 'Early today' or 'After breakfast') (2 marks)

2. Where did Max find his first maths puzzle? (Start with a place adverbial like 'Behind the bush' or 'Near the river') (2 marks)

3. How did Max feel when he solved the puzzle? (Start with a manner adverbial like 'Cheerfully' or 'Excitedly') (2 marks)

4. What happened at the end of the day? (Start with a time adverbial like 'As the sun set' or 'Finally') (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you write one more sentence about what Max found? Try to start it with a fronted adverbial about where he was.
